Bend- Bend Community Center/Senior Meals- 1036 NE 5th Street- low-income seniors lunch available from 11:00am to 1:00pm.

Lapine- Lapine Community Kitchen- 16480 Finley Butte Road lunch served noon to 2:00pm.

Redmond– Redmond Senior Center- 325 NW Dogwood– hot meals starting at noon and Jericho’s Table serving a hot meal from 5:00pm to 6:00pm.

Sisters- Kiwanis Food Bank- 225 N Oak Street– 9:00am to 5:00pm.

Many of these sites will have food bags, propane, blankets, and pet food to be given out while supplies last!
